Group was created by a few survivors of suicide to help in the grieving and healing process. By understanding and sharing stories of loved ones lost, the group is a support system for survivors. This group is sponsored by our Church's Congregational Care ministry.

The S.O.U.L. group's next meeting will be Monday, June 6, at 7:30pm in the FUMC Builders Sunday School Classroom, located under the sanctuary. The meetings are open to anyone in our community who have experienced a loss through suicide.

Whether your loss was a month ago or years ago, you are invited. Meetings are very informal--come as you are! No one is alone in his or her grief and with the help from other survivors, the healing process can begin! Please join us for an uplifting experience and support group!


