## HOLY WEEK • 2019 AD

*"O Savior of the World, who by thy Cross and precious blood hast redeemed us, save us and help us, we humbly beseech Thee, O Lord. Amen."*

### PALM SUNDAY • APRIL 14

Palm Sunday observes the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, recorded by all four Gospel writers, recounting the crowds who were in Jerusalem for Passover waving palm branches and proclaiming Him as the Messiah and King. Jesus rode into the city on a donkey, enacting the prophecy of Zechariah 9:9, and emphasized the humility that was to characterize the Kingdom He proclaimed. Ironically, the cheers of "**Hosanna**" – Save us now! – would change, only five days later, to the jeers of "**Crucify!**", a sobering reminder of our selfish tendency to want God on our own terms.

We enact the Triumphal Entry of Jesus by waving palm branches and singing songs of celebration. Often, the palm branches are fashioned into palm crosses foreshadowing the crucifixion.

### MAUNDY THURSDAY • APRIL 18

The Thursday before Easter is Maundy Thursday. As Jesus and His Disciples were eating the Passover meal, He declares, "**And He took bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, 'This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood'**" (Luke 22:19-20). After the meal, Jesus washes the feet of His disciples and declares, "**A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, you also ought to love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another**" (John 13:34-35). After they finish the meal, they walk into the Garden of Gethsemane where His disciples abandon Him and He is arrested.

The term *Maundy* comes from the Latin word *mandatum* from which we get our English word *mandate* or *commandment*.

On Maundy Thursday, all of the Altar coverings and Christian symbols are removed after Holy Communion is celebrated. Since the Altar symbolizes the sacrificial work of Christ, the "Stripping of the Altar" symbolizes the abandonment of Jesus by His disciples, the stripping of Jesus by the Roman soldiers, His humiliating trial, and the consequences of our sin He willingly endured on the Cross for our salvation.

### GOOD FRIDAY • APRIL 19

The Friday of Holy Week is traditionally called "Good" Friday. The root of the English word, "good" is God. Thus, on Good Friday, or "God" Friday, the church commemorates God's mighty work of salvation through Jesus' in His arrest, trial, crucifixion, suffering, death, and burial. Generally, Processional Crosses are covered in mourning black, the Chancel and Altar coverings are black, and the High Altar candles remain extinguished.

I will share a moving and memorable account of the crucifixion, "**A Doctor at Calvary,**" in which we hear the Seven Last Words of Christ and explore His physical suffering on our behalf. This may be **the single most important service of worship** you ever attend! After experiencing the utter defeat of Good Friday, you will be spiritually ready to celebrate the utter victory of Easter Sunday – Christ the Lord is Risen Today! Alleluia!

I look forward to sharing our first Holy Week experience together.  
Remember how much I love you ... It's an honor to be your Senior Minister!

## Journeying Through Grief Ministry

Losing a loved one is a trying time and your Church wants to be there to give love and support. Congregational Care offers a Journeying Through Grief Book ministry. It includes a set of four short books which we deliver to Church members who have lost a spouse or child.

Book 1 called A Time to Grieve is delivered by one of our Pastors within 3 weeks after the loss. The additional books are delivered by Lay Volunteers:

Book 2 - Experiencing Grief, 3 months after the loss

Book 3 - Finding Hope and Healing, 6 months after the loss

Book 4 - Rebuilding and Remembering, 11 months after the loss

Each book focuses on what the person is likely to be experiencing at that point in grief – offering understanding, empathy, compassion and hope. The books are written by Kenneth Haugk who is a pastor, clinical psychologist and founder of Stephen Ministry and who lost his wife after a long battle with cancer. He walks alongside the reader through the grief journey, sharing helpful insights about grief, biblical truths and stories that provide comfort and reassurance.

We started this ministry less than 2 years ago and have already delivered 13 full book sets plus we currently have 8 additional sets in process of being delivered. Many churches mail such books but we make personal visits to deliver them.

Because we care as you go through your grief journey and want to remind you how much your church loves you.
